Service Unit 26

Program Aide (Girls entering 7th grade and above)

- Complete a Program Aide application
- Must complete one LIA
- Must take PAIT Training held by the Service Unit (3 Hours)
- Must complete an additional 3 hours of specialty training held by the Service Unit
- Works with younger girls over 6 different activities at Linn County Day Camp
- Must have approval from Day Camp Program Director

Cadette Service to GS Bar (Girls entering 8th grade or 2nd year as a Program Aide)

- Must be a Program Aide if working with girls
- In order to earn, girl must complete 20 hours of service for Day Camp
- Must have approval from Day Camp Program Director

Counselor in Training I (Girls entering 9th grade and above)

- Complete a Counselor in Training application
- Completed Program Aide Training
- Has been a Program Aide for 1 year
- Has completed at least 1 Cadette/Senior Journey
- 1 Year of Program Aide must be done at Linn County Day Camp
- Has led at least 4 different activities at Day Camp
- Planned and implemented 2 different badges for younger girls
- Must have approval from Day Camp Program Director

Senior Service to GS Bar (Girls entering 9th grade and above)

- Must be a Program Aide if planning to work with girls
- In order to earn, girl must complete 20 hours of service for Day Camp
- Must have approval from Day Camp Program Director

Counselor in Training II (Girls entering 11th – 12th grade)

- Complete a Counselor in Training application
